	material not submitted by the specified deadline is to be considered,
	taking into account its significance and the effect of a possible need
	to adjourn the hearing.
Hearing of appeal	The fixing of any hearing date will be in accordance with the
	deadlines set out in the Schools Admissions Appeal Code (2012) –
	see note below. Where an appeal is lodged after the appropriate
	deadline a hearing date will be fixed within 30 school days of the
	appeal being lodged.
Decision	Decision letters will be sent within five school days of the hearing,
	wherever possible.

Note: In accordance with the School Admissions Appeal Code (2012), para 2.3:

- 1. For applications made in the normal admissions round, appeals are required to be heard within 40 school days of the deadline for lodging appeals.
- 2. For late applications, appeals will be heard within 40 school days from the deadline for lodging appeals where possible, or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged
- 3. For applications for in-year admissions, appeals are required be heard within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.
