## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT OF SHALOM NOAM PRIMARY SCHOOL

- 1. The name of the school is Shalom Noam Primary School
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school. The school is a qualifying foundation school, whose foundation body is Noam Educational Trust.
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of Shalom Noam Primary School".
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. Two parent governors
  - b. One LA governor
  - c. One staff governor
  - d. One headteacher
  - e. One co-opted governor
  - f. Eight foundation governors
- 5. Total number of governors: 14
- 6. The Noam Educational Trust shall appoint foundation governors.
- 7. The term of office for foundation governors shall be between one year and four years as determined by the Noam Educational Trust as the appointing body at the time of appointment and notified to the clerk. The foundation can remove Foundation Governors. There are no foundation governorships to be held ex officio.
- 8. The term of office for co-opted governors shall be between one year and four years as determined by the governing body of Shalom Noam Primary School as the appointing body at the time of appointment and notified to the clerk.
- 9. The ethos of Shalom Noam Primary School is to provide excellence in primary school education, both secular and Jewish in an environment that is founded upon Orthodox Jewish laws, heritage and culture.
- 10. This instrument of government comes into effect on 19 February 2019.
- 11. The instrument of government was varied with effect from 10 March 2021 and has been further varied, those variations to take effect with effect from the date set out in paragraph 12 below.
- 12. This instrument was made by order of London Borough of Barnet on 2 November 2023.
